You will be responsible for assisting in the delivery and support of Kologik technology while maintaining a high level of reliability. This includes ensuring that all technology used by Kologik and its customers is functional, kept up to date, backed-up, and is managed in a cost-effective manner. This role is also responsible for triaging issues escalated by Kologik employees to ensure that they can accomplish their tasks successfully.

This position also includes leadership responsibilities, such as providing an escalation path for issues to other members of the Kologik team (for both technical and customer service-related items), identifying growth opportunities in the Kologik's use of technology, and by assisting the leadership team in carrying out initiatives by educating team members and enforcing accountability.

An Information Technology Systems Administrator must show initiative, be motivated by technology, have a customer-focused mindset, and maintain a great attention to detail. This role requires a very high level of technical proficiency and requires an individual with executive presence and excellent written and verbal communication skills.

YOUR DAY-TO-DAY

- Support and Maintain Kologik Applications
 - Deploy, configure, maintain, and troubleshoot Azure cloud services including but not limited to:
 - Azure Application Gateway, Azure App Services, Application Insights, Azure SQL Databases, Log Analytics, Networking, Storage, Virtual Machines, and VPN Gateways
 - Develop and maintain high-quality backup and monitoring tools for Kologik systems to ensure they are functioning and performing properly
 - Check logs, verify backups, and review monitoring tools, resources, and applications to ensure security and data integrity
 - Write and maintain PowerShell scripts to automate daily and routine tasks
 - Take ownership of reported customer issues and follow through to a resolution. After resolution is in place, follow up to ensure IT systems are functional.
 - Participate in 24x7 on-call rotation
- Support and Maintain Internal Kologik Applications
 - Administer cloud-based Microsoft 365 platform, primarily OneDrive, Office, Teams, Exchange, and Azure Active Directory (AAD) accounts

- Triage and respond to employee issues and inquiries as soon as possible with accurate information
 - Maintain the company's IT equipment inventory
 - Maintain the company's software subscriptions
- Improve Kologik Policies and Procedures
 - Assist in the development and implementation of the Kologik IT Technology Roadmap
 - Create and maintain a comprehensive IT system, site, and other forms of documentation
 - Work to implement best practice security policies at Kologik and abide by industry security standards
 - Collaborate with Product Management and Engineering teams to design new features and products
 - Participate in continued learning and skills growth; acquisition of assigned certifications
